

Ordinance No 104 Am 161

An Ordinance Concerning Licenses
Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Grand Junction, Colo.

Section 1

All annual license fees, except for liquor licenses, shall be paid in advance in full on the first day of April of each year provided that any person required to secure license by the year may do so at any time upon payment of the full amount required for a years license, but any such license shall expire on the 31st day of March following its issue and no rebate shall be allowed to any such licensee.

Section 2

All Circuses, whether with or without menagerie, shall pay for licenses as follows; namely, a one ring circus fifty dollars per day; for two ring circus, seventy five dollars per day; and a three ring or more, one hundred dollars per day.

Section 3

Section three of Ordinance No 8, being an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Licenses" passed September 26th 1891, and any and all ^{other} ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
