

Ordinance No 187

An Ordinance for the protection of
People Paths

Be it Ordained by the City Council
of the City of Grand Junction Colo.

Sec 1 No Person shall erect at street and
alley intersections, walk upon, or lead side
or drive any animal or any vehicle other than
a bicycle across or upon any bridge path
constructed for the use of bicycles.

Sec 2 Any person who shall violate any
provisions of the foregoing section shall on
conviction be fined not less than two
dollars nor more than one hundred
dollars together with cost.
