

Ordinance No. 108

Annual Appropriation Ordinance
Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Grand Junction, Colorado.

- Sec 1 That the following sums of money, or
so much thereof as shall be necessary,
be and the same are hereby appropriated
for the purpose of defraying the necessary
expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand
Junction for the fiscal year beginning
April 1st A.D. 1902 and ending March 31st
A.D. 1903 to-wit:
- First. For the purpose of maintaining a Police force \$2,000.00
 - Second For the purpose of maintaining, im-
proving and repairing, street corners
crossings, alleys, sidewalks, ditches and
public parks, and for water for irrigat-
ion. 4000.00
 - Third For lighting Street and Public Buildings 1800.00
 - Fourth For the maintenance of the Fire Department 1200.00
 - Fifth For fuel and salaries of City officers other
than Police officers 4750.00
 - Sixth For the City General fund 4500.00
 - Seventh For the maintenance and operation
of the City Water Works 12,000.00
 - Eighth For the payment of interest on City
Water Works Bonds the sum of 5000.00
 - Ninth For the maintenance of the public
Library 1200.00
