

Ordinance No 109.

An Ordinance concerning the salaries and duties of certain City officers.
Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction Colorado

- Sec 1 The salary of the Street Supervisor shall be \$7.80 per annum payable monthly.
- Sec 2 The salary of the City Marshal shall be \$900 per annum payable monthly.
- Sec 3 The salary of the Superintendent of Water Works shall be \$900 per annum payable monthly.
- Sec 4 The salary of the City Clerk shall be \$7.20 per annum payable monthly.
- Sec 5 It shall be the duty of the City Clerk in addition to the duties already required of him by law and ordinance to keep his office in the same office or place as that of the Superintendent of Water Works and he shall personally remain at and keep the said office of City Clerk and the office of said Superintendent of Water Works open for the transaction of business in both of said offices between the hours of 8 and 12 o'clock A.M. and of 1 and 5 o'clock P.M. of each and said City Clerk shall be the Clerk and assistant of the Superintendent of Water Works and perform such clerical duties as may be required of him in said office by said Superintendent of Water Works.

Sec 6 That sections 7, 6 and 9 of Ordinance No 93 passed and adopted the 13 day of March A.D. 1900 and sections 4 and 9 of Ordinance No 92 passed and adopted February 19th A.D. 1900 and any and all other ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
