

Ordinance No 110

An ordinance to vacate the Alley
in Block No 5 of ~~the~~ City of Grand
Junction.

Be it ordained by the City
Council of the City of Grand Junction
Colorado

That whereas J. M. Martin
is the owner of the entire Block No 5 in
said City and has requested that
the alley therein be vacated

Therefore all alleys running
through said Block No 5 in said City
be and the same are hereby vacated.

Provided however that the
right to extend or construct sewers or
any other public utilities in and
through said alleys is hereby expressly
reserved by said City as to the alleys
running North and South and East
from the same, through said block
but if said property should cease at
any time to be used for school purposes
this ordinance shall be null and void
except as to the alley extending West
from the said alley running North and
South.

Introduced and read in open
Council at the regular meeting this
13 day of May A.D. 1902 and ordered
published according to law.
