An ordinance concerning sidewalks
 Be it ordained by the City Council
 of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado
 That hereafter, all new sidewalks
 between Third Street and Sixth Street on
 Main Street, shall be constructed of first
 quality of flagging stone not less
 than three inches thick or of vitrified tile
 or concrete and cement so laid as to make
 a smooth uniform surface. All wooden
 or plank sidewalks within the bounds
 described in this ordinance, when in
 need of repair, shall be taken up removed
 and replaced by the above described
 material.

 this 10 day of June A.D. 1902 and ordered
 published according to law
