

✓ 077 Ordinance No 112

Sec 1 An Ordinance Concerning the Fire Department  
 Be it ordained by the City Council of the  
 City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that hereafter, the Chief of the Fire  
 department and also two Assistants  
 shall be appointed annually by the  
 City Council on the second Monday after  
 the first Tuesday in each year (who  
 shall hold their offices for one year,  
 unless removed and until their successors  
 are elected and qualified.

Sec 2 They shall perform such duties  
 as are by Ordinance already required  
 of the Chief and his assistant and of the  
 Janitor and in addition shall at all  
 times be and remain on duty at the  
 fire department; The Chief of the  
 Fire Department shall also perform  
 the duties of jailer at the City Jail and  
 any of the three shall act as driver of the  
 fire wagon as may be directed by the  
 fire chief.

Sec 3 The Chief of the Fire Department  
 shall receive a salary of \$975.00 per month  
 and each of his assistants a salary of  
 \$450.00 per month, payable monthly in City  
 warrants on the proper fund.

Sec 4 The membership of the volunteer  
 department shall be restricted to fifteen  
 members (who shall be entitled to the  
 following compensation) namely fifty  
 cents per hour or fraction thereof for  
 each hour spent in responding to a  
 fire alarm and performing work at  
 fire.

Sec 5 The office of driver and Janitor are  
 hereby abolished.

Sec 6 All ordinances appropriating money  
 to the volunteer fire department and  
 so much of ordinance No 78 as is in  
 conflict with or inconsistent herewith  
 are hereby repealed.
