

Ordinance No 113

An Ordinance to Amend Sec. 4 of Article 11 of Ordinance No 16 entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Sidewalks" passed Sept. 26 A.D. 1891

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction

That Section 4 of Article 11 of Ordinance No 16 entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Sidewalks" passed Sept. 26th A.D. 1891, shall be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec 4 No bow or other window shall extend into or over any sidewalk; nor shall any sign project from any store or other building into or over any sidewalk, street or alley more than (30) thirty inches; nor shall any cellar door raised project above the surface of the sidewalk; nor shall the hinges thereof or anything connected therewith project or project above the door. Each and every person violating any provision of this section shall on conviction be fined in a sum of five dollars and a like sum for every twenty-four hours he shall continue in such violation after notice to remove the same by the Marshall Street Commissioner or any Policeman.

Introduced and read in open Council and ordered published according to law.
