An Ordinance to Amend Sec. 4 of Article 11
 of Ordinance No 16 entitled "An Ordinance
 Concerning Side-walks" passed Sept. 26 A.D. 1891
 Be it ordained by the City Council
 of the City of Grand Junction
 That Section 4 of Article 11 of Ordinance
 No 16 entitled "An Ordinance Concerning
 Side-walks" passed Sept. 26th A.D. 1891, shall
 be and the same is hereby amended so as to
 read as follows.

Sec 4 No bow or other window shall extend
 into or over any sidewalk; nor shall any
 sign project from any store or other
 building into or over any sidewalk,
 street or alley more than (36) thirty inches;
 nor shall any cellar door, raised or project
 above the surface of the sidewalk; nor
 shall the hinges thereof or anything
 connected therewith project or raise
 above the door. And every person
 violating any provision of this section
 shall on conviction be fined in a sum
 of five dollars and a like sum for every
 twenty-four hours he shall continue
 in such violation after notice to remove
 the same by the Marshall, Street Com-
 missioner or any Policeman.
