An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 6, being an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning the Fire Limits"

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo

That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 6, entitled "An Ordinance Concerning the Fire Limits" be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

All that portion of the City of Grand Junction embraced within the following limits of said City to-wit; Beginning at the intersection of Second Street and the alley between Colorado Avenue and 10th Avenue, thence East along said alley to its intersection with Sixth Street, thence North along said Sixth Street to its intersection with the alley between Main and Colorado Ave, thence east along said alley to its intersection with Seventh Street, thence North along said Seventh Street to its intersection with the alley between Main Street and Road Avenue thence West along said alley to its intersection with Sixth Street, thence North along said Sixth Street to Road Avenue, thence West along Road Avenue to its intersection with Third, thence South along said Third Street to its intersection with the alley between Road Avenue and Main Street, thence West along the alley to its intersection with Second Street, thence South along said Second Street to the place of beginning
