

# Ordinance No 116.

Annual Appropriation Ordinance  
Be it Ordained by the City Council of  
the City of Grand Junction, Colorado,

- Sec 1 That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of ~~the~~ City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning April 1st 1903 and ending March 31st 1904 to wit:
  - First For the purpose of maintaining a police force \$ 2200<sup>00</sup>
  - Second For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing streets, Alleys, Avenues, Crossings, sidewalks, ditches and public parks, and for water for irrigation \$ 5,000<sup>00</sup>
  - Third For lighting streets and public buildings \$ 1,800<sup>00</sup>
  - Fourth For the maintenance of the Fire Department \$ 2600<sup>00</sup>
  - Fifth For fees and salaries of City officers, other than, police officers, members of the Fire Department and Officers and employees of the City Water Works \$ 4,000<sup>00</sup>
  - Sixth For the maintenance and operation of the City Water Works \$ 10,000<sup>00</sup>
  - Seventh For the payment of interest on City Water Works Bonds \$ 5,000<sup>00</sup>
  - Eight For the maintenance of the Public Library \$ 1,200<sup>00</sup>
  - Ninth For the City General Fund \$ 4,000<sup>00</sup>
