

Ordinance No 118 Am. 96

An Ordinance to Amend Section 2 of Ordinance No 96, being an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance concerning Sewers," passed and adopted on the 18th day of July, 1900

Sec 1

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo. That Section 2 of the above named Ordinance be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows

Sec 2

No ditch or surface water shall be drained into the public or district sewers, nor shall any water from houses or building roofs be allowed to enter the same and any and all connections with said sewer from house roofs shall from this date be unlawful, and such connections shall, upon notice from the Sewer Committee, be detached

Sec 3

Any person violating any of the provisions of the foregoing sections shall upon conviction be fined in a sum not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each offense, together with costs and each days default, neglect or refusal to comply with the provisions of this ordinance or the orders of the Sewer Committee shall be deemed a distinct and separate offense

Introduced and read in open Council this 17 day of March, 1903 and ordered published as required by law.
