

Ordinance No. 119

An Ordinance Concerning Privies, Water Closets and Urinals.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction Colorado,

Sec 1

That it shall be the duty of every person owning property upon which any merchant, manufacturer or other person or corporation is conducting any business in this city, having one or more persons in their employ, at said place of business, to construct and provide for the use of such employes, a privy or water closet and Urinal, in or adjacent to the said place of business.

Sec 2

A Failure for more than ten days after the passage of this ordinance to comply with the provisions of the foregoing section shall be an offense, punishable on conviction by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than two hundred dollars and costs, and each days failure to so comply shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

Introduced and read in open council this 17 day of March A D 1903, and Ordered published as required by law.
