

Ordinance No 120

An Ordinance to provide for the rate of compensation of the employees of the City of Grand Junction.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction

Section 1. All persons employed by the street commissioners of the City of Grand Junction and all other persons employed by the City, not in an official capacity, shall receive the following amounts as compensation for their services, Namely: Ordinary laborers \$2.00 per day. Carpenters and tradesman, \$3.00 per day. Teams with driver and wagons or scrapers \$3.50 per day.

Section 2. Section three of Article five of Ordinance eleven passed and adopted September 26th, 1899, and all other ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

This ordinance was passed and adopted July 15, 1903
