

## Ordinance No 172

An Ordinance To provide for Licensing and Regulating  
Certain Occupations.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Grand Junction.

Section One: — That from and after the passage of this Ordinance no person, <sup>firm, firm, or</sup> association or corporation shall within the City of Grand Junction conduct an Employment Agency as defined by Section One page 188 of the laws of 1891 of the State of Colorado, without first having obtained a license so to do.

Section Two: — The license fee for conducting an Employment Agency in this city as required by Section One of this Ordinance shall be \$25<sup>00</sup> per year, payable in advance as provided by Section Three of said act of 1891, and such license shall be issued only upon application to the City Council as provided by said act.

Section Three: — Every person, persons, association or corporation who shall hereafter obtain a license as herein provided, shall observe each and all of the requirements of said Act of 1891 and shall give a bond in the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000), conditioned as in said Act provided, which shall be approved by the City Council, before the issuance of license, and if any person, persons, association or corporation to whom a license shall have been issued shall fail to keep and observe all the requirements of said Act of 1891, the license to him shall by order of the City Council be forfeited and cancelled.

Section Four: — Any person, persons, association or corporation who shall engage in conducting managing or operating an Employment Agency within this city without first having obtained a license so to do shall be deemed guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

Section Five: — No person, persons, association or corporation shall conduct or operate within this city any bowling alley or pin alley without having obtained a license so to do in the same manner as

provided for the issuance of license for shooting galleries and like amusements, provided, that the license fee for bowling alleys and fire alleys shall be \$35.00 per annum, payable in advance. Any person, persons, association or corporation that shall engage in conducting or operating a bowling alley or fire alley within this city without license so to do shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

Section Six: - No person, persons, association or corporation shall auction goods, chattels, wares or merchandise within the city of Grand Junction without having first obtained a license so to do, which said license shall be obtained and issued as licenses are obtained for the running of drug wagons in this city, provided, that the license shall be \$30.00 per annum or \$2.00 per day payable in advance. Any person, persons, association or corporation who shall auctioneer any goods, chattels, wares or merchandise in this city without first having obtained a license so to do, shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each offense, provided, that a license shall not be required for the <sup>sale of</sup> goods, chattels, wares or merchandise by sheriffs, coroners, marshalls, executors, guardians, assignees of insolvent debtors or bankrupts or any other person required by law to sell property at auction.

Section Seven: - This Ordinance shall in no way repeal or modify any former Ordinance of the City of Grand Junction, except as herein expressly provided.
