

Ordinance No. 123

An ordinance in relation to Spitting on Sidewalks,
Stairs and other Public Walks.

Be it Ordained By The City Council of the City of
Grand Junction,

Action 1: — That spitting upon sidewalks, stairs
and other public walks within the City of Grand Junction is
hereby declared to be a nuisance and from and after the
passage of this Ordinance, no person shall spit upon any
of the public sidewalks within this city nor upon any or
in any stairway contained in any office building or
public building within this city.

Action 2: Any Person violating the provisions
of Action One of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty
of an offence and upon conviction shall be fined not
less than \$5⁰⁰ nor more than \$100⁰⁰.

This Ordinance was passed and adopted January
12th, 1904.
