

Ordinance No 124

Annual appropriation ordinance of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, to provide for the expenses of the City of Grand Junction, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1904 and ending March 31, 1905.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be, and the same hereby are appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1904 and ending April 1, 1905, namely:

- First: For maintaining a police force \$2750.
- Second: For maintaining, improving and ^{repairing} streets, alleys and public parks and ^{for water for irrigation} \$6000.
- Third: For lighting streets of public buildings \$2400
- Fourth: For maintenance of fire department \$3000
- Fifth: For fees and salaries of city officers other than police officers, members of fire department and officers and employees of city waterworks. 4000
- Sixth: For improving, maintaining and operating city waterworks \$1875.
- Seventh: For the payment of interest on City waterworks bonds 5000.
- Eighth: For the maintenance of public library 1200.
- Ninth: For the general expenses of the city (General fund) 4500.

This ordinance was passed and adopted February 9, 1904.
