

# Ordinance No. 127.

and

Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, Provided for the expenses of the City of Grand Junction for the Fiscal year beginning April 1, 1905 and ending March 31, 1906.

Be it Ordained By the City Council of the City of Grand Junction;

Section I.

That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same hereby are appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1905 and ending March 31, 1906.

- First - For maintaining a police force 3000 00
  - Second - For maintaining, improving and repairing streets, alleys and public parks and for water for irrigation. 6000 00
  - Third - For lighting streets and public buildings 4800 00
  - Fourth - For maintenance of fire department 3200 00
  - Fifth - For fees and salaries of city officers other than police officers, members of fire department, and officers and employees of the city waterworks. 4200 00
  - Sixth - For improving, maintaining and operating city waterworks. 14500 00
  - Seventh - For the payment of interest on city water works bonds. 5000 00
  - Eighth - For the maintenance of public library 1200 00
  - Ninth - For the general expenses of the City (General Fund) 3600 00
- Total 45500 00
