

Ordinance No. 128. ^{twist}

An Ordinance establishing the Compensation and Salaries of City Officers.

Action I

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado.

From and after the passage of this Ordinance the Salaries of the officers of the City of Grand Junction shall be as follows.

- 1st The Mayor \$30⁰⁰ per month payable monthly.
- 2^d City Clerk \$40⁰⁰ from salary fund and \$40⁰⁰ from water fund per month, payable monthly.
- 3^d City Treasurer \$30⁰⁰ per month payable monthly.
- 4th City Marshal \$90⁰⁰ per month payable monthly.
- 5th City Attorney \$60⁰⁰ per month payable monthly, and also a fee of \$5⁰⁰ to be taxed against the Defendant in each case.
- 6th City Street Supervisor \$80⁰⁰ per month payable monthly.
- 7th Superintendent of Waterworks \$1200⁰⁰ per year payable monthly.
- 8th Chief of Fire Department \$900⁰⁰ per year payable monthly, the first assistant chief of Fire Department \$440⁰⁰ per year payable monthly, the second assistant chief of Fire Department \$720⁰⁰ per annum payable monthly.
- 9th Alderman, each \$10⁰⁰ per month payable monthly.
- 10th City Physician \$20⁰⁰ per month payable monthly.
- 11th Police Magistrate \$10⁰⁰ per month payable monthly, and also such fees as are provided by law for justices of the Peace in Mesa County, for like services, provided the city shall not be liable for any fees.

Action 2.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction this 16th day of March A.D. 1905
