

## Ordinance 136.

An Ordinance amending Section 2, of Article 1, of Ordinance No. 16, being an Ordinance concerning the sidewalks passed and adopted September 26, A. D. 1891.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, State of Colorado.

That Section 2, of Article 1, of Ordinance 16, being an Ordinance concerning sidewalks, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Unless otherwise specified in the order, all sidewalks shall be constructed of first quality of flagging stone, not less than two inches thick, or of vitrified tile, concrete or asphalt, so laid as to make a smooth and uniform surface; the whole to be laid to the established grade, as established by Ordinance 133 of an Ordinance concerning grades and establishing street grades.

Sidewalks shall be repaired with the same kind of material as that used in the original construction of the same.
