Ordinance No. 141

Amendment to Section ^{ten} of Ordinance No. 125 and ~~Ordinance No. 137.~~

An Ordinance to amend section 10 of Ordinance No. 125, being an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance granting to George Smith, his successors and assigns, the right to construct, maintain and operate a system of street railway and granting the right of way therefor, within the City of Grand Junction, Colorado."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that section ten of Ordinance No. 125 being an Ordinance granting to George Smith, his successors and assigns the right to construct maintain and operate a system of street railway, and granting a right of way therefor within the City of Grand Junction; be amended to read as follows:

Section X

--- The said George Smith, his successors, associates and assigns shall construct at least two miles of railroad and equip the same, and have it in operation within the corporate limits of Grand Junction, and upon the streets above described by or before the 31st day of March, 1907 and shall construct, equip and have in operation at least one mile of additional track every twelve months thereafter, until the said railway shall be constructed the full length of all such streets as are specifically mentioned herein; and if any portion of said streets shall not have constructed, equipped and operated therein lines of railroad to their full extent at the expiration from the said 31st day of March, A.D. 1907, ^{then the right herein shall be forfeited upon such portion of such streets as they do not do}

obliged by the construction and operation of said railway thereon. Provided further that the time of default in the bond herebefore made by George Smith and his associates shall be and hereby is extended to and until the 31st day of March, A.D. 1907.
