Ordinance No. 142

Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado. Provides for the expenses of the City of Grand Junction for the Fiscal year beginning April 1st, A. D. 1907 and ending, March 31st, A. D. 1908.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction;

Section I.

That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the Fiscal year beginning April 1st, A. D. 1907 and ending March 31st, A. D. 1908.

First.-- For maintaining a Police Force.	\$ 3260.00
Second.-- For maintaining, improving and repairing Streets, Alleys and Public Parks and for Water for irrigation.	\$ 10,000.00
Third.-- For lighting Streets and Public buildings.	\$ 6500.00
Fourth.-- For maintenance of Fire Department.	\$ 4000.00
Fifth.-- For Fees and Salaries of City Officers other than Police Officers, members of Fire Department, and Officers and employees of the City Water Works.	\$ 4440.00
Sixth.-- For improving, maintaining and operating City Water Works.	\$ 14500.00
Seventh.-- For the payment of interest on City Water Works Bonds.	\$ 12500.00
Eighth.-- For the maintenance of Public Library.	\$ 1200.00
Ninth.-- For the General expenses of the City, (General Fund).	\$ 4000.00
Total	\$ 60400.00
