

Ordinance No. 145.

An Ordinance Concerning Billiard and Pool Tables.

Section I.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, State of Colorado, as follows:-

No person or persons, Corporation or its agents, clerks or employees, shall in any place of public resort, in this City, keep, or use, maintain or operate, any Billiard or Pool table, without first obtaining a license or permit, so to do.

Section II.

Keepers of Billiard tables mentioned in the preceding section, shall for every table kept and used, pay to the City the sum of Ten dollars for the term of One year and the sum of Five dollars for the term of Six months and Keepers of Pool tables mentioned in the preceding section, shall for every table kept and used, pay to the City the sum of Ten Dollars for the term of One year and the sum of Five Dollars for the term of Six months.

Section III.

Any Keeper of any table mentioned in this Ordinance who shall suffer or permit, any person under the age of Eighteen Years to play on any such table without the written permission of the parent or guardian of any such minors, first had and obtained shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00.

Section IV.

Any Keeper of any of the tables mentioned in this Ordinance, who shall allow any person to play thereon, between the hours of Twelve O'clock midnight and Six O'clock in the morning of each day in the week, and between the hours of Twelve O'clock Saturday night and Six O'clock Monday morning of each and every week, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00.

This ordinance to be in force from and after its passage, and all Ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
