

Ordinance No. 147.

An Ordinance concerning and regulating the speed of bicycles, tricycles, velocipedes, automobiles, and other riding machines.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado.

Section I

No person shall upon any street of common use in the City of Grand Junction, ride or drive or cause to be ridden or driven any bicycle, tricycle, velocipede, automobile or other riding machine immoderately or in any manner to interfere or interrupt travelers thereon.

Section II

Any speed that is greater than at the rate of 8 miles per hour is hereby deemed immoderate, and in violation of this Ordinance,

Section III

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and fined in a sum of not less than five Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars.

This Ordinance to be in force and effect from and after its passage and all Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
