

Historic Preservation Board Retreat

The Board convened at 4:00 pm at the Museum of Western Colorado

Minutes of October 4, 2010 Meeting. Zebulon Miracle made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2010 meeting as presented. The motion passed unanimously (6-0) on a second by Jon Schler.

Discussion of Future Projects. The Board continued its discussion of the list of items briefly discussed at its retreat in August including the following items:

- 2011 Landscapes West Expo with the Botanical Gardens will be held March 10-13 at Two Rivers. Jon Schler will look into a free booth for the Board to provide Historic Preservation information.
- Expanding the web page with more information and links – funding, books, NTHP magazine, National Parks Service Tech Briefs, updated links to the Colorado Historical Society and Colorado Preservation, Inc. – the Board would like to update the City's web page again to become available during Historic Preservation Month (May).
- Participate in Downtown Operation Foresight Anniversary celebration (50 years in 2012). Kristen will research who is involved in the celebration to let them know the Board is interested in participating in the planning, providing photos, etc.
- Proactively work with property owners for local historic designation. Jon Schler suggested the Board first learn more about what areas/properties have been inventoried in order to further discuss. Kristen will bring information and maps to future Board meeting(s) regarding Phases 1-3 of surveys that have been completed over the last 15 years.

Additional Ideas: Jon Schler suggested the Board look into creating information available, possible tours, etc of certain architectural styles that are prevalent in the older areas of the City – e.g. Craftsman/Bungalow in downtown. Could be done in conjunction with Historic Preservation Month.
