Ordinance No. 151 of 1908.

An Ordinance Creating and establishing a fund to be designated as the park fund and to be used for the maintenance and improvement of the public parks of the City of Grand Junction.

Whereas the City Council of the City of Grand Junction consider it proper and of necessity that the public parks of the said City be taken care of and be made suitable and convenient places of amusement and pleasure for the inhabitants of the said City of Grand Junction, and

Whereas the City is without funds available at this time to be used for the improvement and protection of the said parks of the City, and

Whereas the Grand Junction Electric Gas & Mfg. Co, a corporation, organized and existing under, and by virtue of the laws of the State of Colorado, and also doing business within the corporate limits of the said City of Grand Junction under a franchise which expires 1932 and under a contract with the said City by which it pays to the City and into the treasury thereof a sum equal to 3% of the gross receipts of said Company and which is paid quarterly.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

Section I.

That there is hereby created and established a fund to be known as the park fund of said City, which said fund shall consist of any and all monies, levied, collected and appropriated therefor by the said City Council and coming into the said fund by donation or otherwise and particularly any and all monies received under the terms of the aforesaid Contract between the said City of Grand Junction and said Electric Gas & Mfg. Co.

Section 2.

all monies collected and credited to the said park fund as aforesaid shall be used for the maintenance and improvement of the parks of the City of Grand Junction and shall be deposited in the treasury of such City to the credit of the park fund and shall be kept separate and apart from other monies of said City, and any portion thereof remaining unexpended at the end of any fiscal year or any other time shall not, in any event, be converted into the general fund or be subject to appropriation for general purposes.
