MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 7, 2006 MEETING: Tom Streff made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 7, 2006 meeting as presented. The motion passed unanimously on a second by Kathy Jordan.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH UPDATE: The Board discussed upcoming events for May. Kathy Jordan reported that plans for the Historic Home Tour are progressing. It will be held on Saturday May 5th. It was decided that the historic preservation award would be presented at the tour to Brad and Terry Hance, residents in the historic district. Kathy and Kristen will coordinate details. Kristen submitted a grant application to the Colorado Historical Society to help with costs for the tour.

Zebulon Miracle went over a list of events that will be sponsored by the Museum during May including both history and archaeological programs.

125th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION: Most members of the Board are participating on the various planning committees for the anniversary celebration. The Board will be sponsoring a silent film during the celebration weekend on Saturday June 30th at 1:00 at the Avalon instead of the annual film during Historic Preservation Month. Kristen is working on procuring The Great K&A Train Robbery from the Glenwood Springs Museum and will coordinate other details.

OTHER: Several applications have been received for appointments to the Board. City Council is expected to make appointments in the near future.

Kristen announced that the Riverside School is now open and being used by the Riverside Task Force, the Riverside Educational Center and the School District for the Dual Immersion Academy. It was decided that the Board would like to schedule a tour of the building for its March meeting.
