**TOUR OF RIVERSIDE SCHOOL:** The Board was given a tour of the recently remodeled and reopened Riverside School by Riverside Task Force Director Kelley Schaefer. The school is being used by the Dual Immersion Academy for daily activities including the library, art room, computer lab, cafeteria and multipurpose room. The Task Force offices are in the basement of the building and they organize evening community events held at the school. The Riverside Educational Center is using some of the rooms 3 afternoons a week for tutoring and educational services.
