

Ordinance No. 160

An ordinance calling a special election for the purpose of electing members of a Charter Convention for the city of Grand Junction and fixing the time and place for the holding of such Charter Convention, and also fixing the time when the proposed Charter framed by said convention shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said city for the approval or rejection, and making provisions for matters relating thereto.

Be it ordained by the city Council of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado

Sec. I That a special election be conducted as provided by law of the qualified electors of the city of Grand Junction, State of Colorado, for the election of twenty-one (21) taxpayers, who shall have been qualified electors within the limits of said city for at least five (5) years, and who, when elected, shall constitute a Charter convention to frame a Charter for said city in harmony with article XX of the constitution of the State of Colorado, is hereby called to be held on Tuesday the 8th day of June, A.D. 1909.

Sec. II The members of said Charter Convention shall be elected from said city at large, and shall complete their labors within sixty days after said election. All provisions of said article XX, so far as applicable to cities of first and second class in this state, shall be complied with and shall govern on all questions arising under this ordinance.

Sec. III Said Charter Convention shall be held at the hour of ten o'clock on Saturday, the 12th day of June, A.D. 1909, at the Council Chamber in the new city Hall, in said city, and said convention may adjourn from time to time, within said sixty days, as it may determine, until the completion of said Charter.

Sec. IV No officer or member of said convention shall receive any compensation for his services.

Sec. V The proposed Charter so framed by said convention shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said city of Grand Junction for their approval or rejection at a special election to be conducted as provided by law, which is hereby called to be held within said city on the first Tuesday next, following the 35th day after the delivery of said proposed Charter to the city Clerk of said city.
