

Ordinance #163

An Ordinance concerning offences in the nature of misdemeanors.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

- Sec. I It shall be unlawful for any person, other than a passenger or employee of the company owning or operating any street railway car or cars within the limits of the City of Grand Junction, to ride, or attempt to ride, upon any street railroad car, or attempt to board any of said cars while in motion within the corporate limits of the City of Grand Junction.
- The term "Passenger" used in this connection, shall mean any person going upon or into street car with the bona fide intention of paying his or her fare, in conformity with the rules and regulations of the company operating such car, and shall include any person going or riding upon said car by and with the consent and permission of said Company.
- Sec. II Any person who shall violate the provisions, or any of them, of the foregoing section, shall, upon conviction, be fined for each offence in a sum not less than five dollars (\$5⁰⁰) nor more than Fifty dollars (\$50⁰⁰), and this ordinance shall apply to minors as well as adults.
- Sec. III No person shall place any stone, timber or other obstruction upon any street railway track or railroad track within the limits of the City of Grand Junction, nor shall any person throw or discharge any stone or other missile upon or at any train or car of any railroad or street railway company, or at any arc or other light, wires, poles, insulator or transformer of any electric light company, or other public or private property, or in any manner interfere with the tracks of any railroad or street railway company, or the overhead wires, poles, or other property, of any street railway company, or electric light company within the limits of

the city of Grand Junction.

Sec. IV. Any person found guilty of any violation of any of the provisions of Sec. three of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined in a sum not less than five dollars (\$5⁰⁰) or more than one hundred dollars (\$100⁰⁰) for each offence.
