An Ordinance concerning Water Service Pipes in the Business District of the City of Grand Junction.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction.

- Sec. I The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the following named streets and Avenues, and portions of Street and Avenues of the City of Grand Junction, to-wit: Second St. from the property line of the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad Company to Main St., Pitkin Avenue west from Second Street to the property line of the Denver and Rio Grand Railroad Co., Main Street from Second Street to Seventh St., Colorado Avenue from Second Street to Sixth St., Third Street from Colorado Avenue to Main Street, Fourth Street from Ute Avenue to Road Avenue, Fifth Street from Ute Avenue to White Avenue, Sixth Street from Colorado Avenue to Road Avenue.
- Sec. II All Water Service Pipes which shall be hereafter laid by any property owner or water user to connect with any of the water mains within the above mentioned streets and Avenues, in the said City of Grand Junction shall be of extra heavy ($\frac{3}{4}$) three quarter inch lead pipe from the water main to the curb line.
- Sec. III Whenever any repairs are required for any water service pipe within the above district, which is not of lead, the said water service pipe shall be relaid from the water main to the curb line with extra heavy three quarter inch ($\frac{3}{4}$) lead pipe.
- Sec. IV All water users taking water from mains within the above described district shall, before the streets and avenues are paved, relay all water service pipes not now composed of lead pipe with extra heavy three quarter inch ($\frac{3}{4}$) lead pipe from water main to the curb line. The Water Superintendent shall notify in writing the said water users of the proposed paving of said streets and Avenues or any portion thereof,

and the lead service pipes hereby provided for shall be laid within fifteen (15) days of the service of such notice.

Sec. v The Superintendent of Water Works shall refuse any tap permit for water service pipe which does not comply with the provisions of this ordinance and any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, on conviction thereof, be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10⁰⁰) nor more than one hundred (\$100⁰⁰) dollars, and any licensed plumber or plumbers who shall lay any water service pipes in violation of this ordinance, shall forfeit his or their license.
