

Ordinance #166

An Ordinance Concerning "Fire Limits"
 Be it ordained by the City Council of the
 City of Grand Junction.

Sec. I

All that portion of the city of Grand Junction embraced within the following described limits shall be known as the "Fire Limits" of the City of Grand Junction, to-wit: commencing at the intersection of the east line of First Street and the south line of Road Avenue, running thence east along the south line of Road Avenue to its intersection with the west line of Eighth Street, thence south along the west line of Eighth Street to its intersection with the west ^{part} of Colorado Ave., thence west along the north line of Colorado Avenue to its intersection with the west side of Sixth Street, thence south along the west side of Sixth Street to its intersection with the north side with the north side of the Alley running through Block 126, thence west along the north side of said Alley to its intersection with the west line of Third Street, thence south along the west line of Third Street to the southeast corner of Block 145, thence west along the south side of said Block 145 to the property line of the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad Company, thence northwesterly along the said property line to its intersection with the east line of First Street, thence west along the east line of First Street to the place of beginning.

Sec. II

All the provisions of ordinance #6 entitled, "An ordinance concerning Fire Limits" and of all ordinances amendatory thereof, shall apply to the Fire Limits herein designated.
