

Ordinance No. 159

An ordinance to amend an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance No. 152 granting to Horace, K. Devereaux and Eugene, A. Sunderland, their heirs and assigns, the right, privilege and franchise to erect, construct, operate and maintain a street railway on certain streets, avenues, alleys, and public places of and within the city of Grand Junction, and to use the same for such street railway purposes" passed July 17th 1908 and approved July 21st 1908

Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Grand Junction:

- Sec. 1 That upon the written consent heretofore submitted to the city council, and filed with the city clerk, of the owners of the land representing more than one half of the frontage of the following described portions of streets and avenues sought to be used for railway purposes, section one (1) of an ordinance entitled "An ordinance No. 152 granting to Horace, K. Devereaux and Eugene, A. Sunderland, their heirs and assigns, the right, privilege and franchise to erect, construct, operate and maintain, a street railway, on certain streets, avenues, alleys, and public places of and within the city of Grand Junction, and to use the same for such street railway purposes" passed July 17th 1908 and approved July 21st 1908, be, and the same hereby is amended by inserting at the end of said section one (1) the following words, to-wit: -
- "Second Street from north line of Pitkin Ave. to the east line of the lands of the D & R. G. Ry. Co., South Avenue between Third Street and the east line of the D & R. G. Ry. Co., and between the west line of Eleventh Street and the east line of Twelfth Street, and on Twelfth Street between the north line of Pitkin Avenue and the south city limits, and on Tenth Street between South Avenue and south city limits; and on Fifth Street between South Avenue and a

point at right angles with the west line of Block 161 as shown in the original plat of the townsite of the city of Grand Junction.

Sec. II That said amendments and each of them shall have like force and effect from and after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance as if originally contained in said ordinance No. 152 law passed July 17th 1908, and approved July 21st 1908.

Sec. III This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
