## An Ordinance Concerning Automobiles.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

- Sec. I No automobile shall be driven at a speed greater than ten (10) miles per hour.
- Sec. II All automobiles upon the streets of the city of Grand Junction shall be driven upon the right <sup>hand</sup> side of the street and shall observe all the laws and customs of the road.
- Sec. III All automobiles driven upon the streets of the city of Grand Junction must be equipped with two headlights, or searchlights, two side lights and one tail light, which lights shall be kept burning continuously while the automobile is upon the public streets of the city of Grand Junction at any time between one half hour after sunset and one half hour before sunrise.
- Sec. IV No person shall drive an automobile within the city of Grand Junction until he shall have first obtained an automobile drivers license, for which license he shall pay a fee of one (\$<sup>1.00</sup>) dollar per year. Each license shall be numbered and a record of the license number of each driver shall be kept on file by the city clerk. Each owner of an automobile shall display his license number upon the rear of his car in figures not less than four inches in height, in such a position that they can be plainly seen.
- Sec. V Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than five (\$<sup>5.00</sup>) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$<sup>100.00</sup>) dollars for each offense.
- Sec. VI The license of any automobile driver convicted of a first or second offense under the provisions of this ordinance may be revoked at the discretion of the City Council by a majority vote at any meeting thereof; and the license of a driver convicted of a third offense under the provisions of this

ordinance, shall be revoked and canceled. No license shall be issued to any driver whose license has been revoked for violations of this ordinance within one year of the time said license was revoked, nor shall any license be issued to any such driver after a period of one year unless this application therefore shall be approved by the City Council.

Sec. VII

A. copy of this ordinance shall be printed on the back of each license issued to any automobile driver, and the attention of the licensee shall be directed to its provisions.
