

## Ordinance #170

## An Ordinance Concerning an Emergency Appropriation.

Whereas, since the adoption of the Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year ending March 31<sup>st</sup> 1910, an unforeseen emergency has arisen because of the high waters in the river, and the necessity of installing a new boiler and making other repairs, and the appropriation for the water fund for said year has by reason of said emergency been exhausted.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

Sec. 1 That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the funds now on hand to the credit of the Water fund, the sum of five thousand (\$5000) dollars.
