

Ordinance No. 172

An Ordinance Concerning Salaries.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1

The salaried employes of the city shall consist of the following named persons with the monthly salaries set opposite their names, said salaries to be payable at the close of each and every month.

The City Surveyor shall receive no salary but shall be allowed to charge and demand in advance the following fees from the owners of the property ordering the work to be done, or against whom the same is properly chargeable: For surveying any one lot, \$2.00; for surveying every additional lot at the same time, and owned by the same person, \$1.00; for furnishing street grade for each lot, \$2.00; for any work performed for the City pay shall be as follows: \$1.00 per hour for the first ten days; when ten days and not more than fifteen days in any one month, 80 cents per hour; when fifteen days to a full month, 70 cents per hour.

Sec. 2 All fees of the City Attorney and Police shall be paid into the City Treasury and belong to the City.
