Ordinance No. 173.

An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance No. 110, entitled, "An Ordinance to Vacate the alleys of Block 5 of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado," passed and adopted on the 10th day of June, 1902, and to restore, relocate and re-establish said alleys.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1

That Ordinance No. 110, entitled "An Ordinance to vacate the alleys in Block No. 5 of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado," passed and adopted on the 10th day of June, 1902, shall be and the same hereby is repealed.

Sec. 2

All of the alleys in said block which were vacated by said above described Ordinance No. 110 shall be and the same hereby are restored, relocated, and re-established the same as though said ordinance vacating the same had never been passed.
