

Ordinance No. 174.Special Appropriation Ordinance for
the Years 1909 and 1910.

Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1 That the following sums of money or so much
thereof as shall be necessary, be and the
same are hereby appropriated for the purpose
of defraying the necessary expenses and
liabilities of the City of Grand Junction for
the years 1909 and 1910, to-wit:

4	For the Fire department	4500 00
5	For lighting the streets and public buildings	7500 00
6	For the Public Library	1200 00
7	For Salaries of City Officers and Employees	8760 00
8	For the Health Department	2840 00
9	For Care and Maintenance of the Public Parks	1860 00
10	For Interest on Water Bonds	16100 00
11	For the General Fund	8000 00
