

This was a huge step forward for our industry in Utah because it gives Utah laws similar to those in Nebraska and Michigan, where we are not required to charge sales tax on parts or labor sales to our customers.

West Star Taxes

- In Fiscal Year 2009
 - WSA Paid ~\$326,000
 - Fuel & OTC Parts Sales Tax Paid ~\$81,000
 - Work Order Sales Tax Paid ~\$245,000
 - WSA is <u>not</u> asking for relief on Fuel Sales Taxes
 - WSA is <u>not</u> asking for relief on OTC Parts Sales



Impacts

- Competitive pressure could result in:
 - Conservatively, 30 jobs lost @ \$50,000/year/job
 - Financial Impact over five years of:
 - Payroll loss of \$8,011,606
 - City Revenue of \$61,490
 - Total Direct Economic Benefit (loss) to city (\$6,110,253)
 - Total Indirect Economic Benefit (loss) to city (\$22,239,758)
