ORDINANCE NO. 249.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW NAMES FOR THE SEVERAL PARKS BELONGING TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That the block or tract of land now designated on the official map of the city as "Maple Park," and bounded on the north by Ute avenue, on the east by Fifth street, on the south by Pitkin avenue, and on the west by Fourth street, is hereby named and shall hereafter be known as Whitman Park.

- Sec. 2. That the block or tract of land now designated on the official map of the city as "Cottonwood Park," and bounded on the north by Ute avenue, on the east by Tenth street, on the south by Pitkin avenue, and on the west by Ninth street, is hereby named and shall hereafter be known as Emerson Park.
- Sec. 3. That the block or tract of land now designated on the official map of the city as "Walnut Park," and bounded on the north by Hill avenue, on the east by Fifth street, on the south by Gunnison avenue, and on the west by Fourth street, is hereby named and shall hereafter be known as Hawthorne Park.
- Sec. 4. That the block or tract of land now designated on the official map of the city as "Chestnut Park," and bounded on the north by Hill avenue, on the east by Tenth street, on the south by Gunnison avenue, and on the west by Ninth street, is hereby named and shall hereafter be known as Washington Park.
