

Historic Preservation Board Meeting

Minutes – March 2, 2004

MINUTES: Tom Streff made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 3, 2004 meeting. Motion was passed on a second by Bill Cort (5-0).

2004 HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH: The Board discussed the events that are being proposed for 2004 Historic Preservation Month. Kristen is working with Tom Streff to coordinate the annual art display. Tom has met with the interested high school art teachers and expect participation by Grand Junction, Palisade and Fruita Monument High Schools. Kristen has secured the display space at Wells Fargo Bank downtown for the month of May.

A date of Friday, May 14th has been set to show the silent film *The Iron Horse* at The Avalon. Kristen will work on details with the Cinema at The Avalon for ticket sales, concessions, etc. The Avalon will like show a film at 5:00 and then the silent film will follow at 7:30. Bill Jones will follow up with Dave Fishell about doing an introductory presentation as he did last year. Kristen will follow up with Jeannie Thomas to do the piano accompaniment again. Kristen noted that The Avalon no longer has a piano. If the pianist needs one to use, Bill Cort offered to inquire at one of the downtown music stores about loaning/moving one for the evening.

Kristen will inquire about/coordinate presentation of the Historic Preservation Award at the May 19, 2004 City Council meeting.

Zebulon Miracle will provide information to be passed on to the State for its events brochure for upcoming events in May including the Park Opera House and the Then and Now exhibits.

Kristen applied for the two small grants (\$250 each) available through the Colorado Historical Society to help with funding for both the art exhibit and the film events.
