

ORDINANCE NO. 250.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING LICENSES AND RIDING BICYCLES ON PUBLIC SIDEWALKS.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. The charge for licenses running for less than six months and for which a six months rate is provided, shall be as follows:

- 1 month, 30 per cent. of six months' rate.
- 2 months, 50 per cent. of six months' rate.
- 3 months, 65 per cent. of six months' rate.
- 4 months, 80 per cent. of six months' rate.
- 5 months, 90 per cent. of six months' rate.

Provided, however, an express license shall not be issued for the month of December or any part thereof for less than \$5.00.

Section 2. No person shall in the City of Grand Junction ride or drive a bicycle or motor cycle upon any of the public sidewalks thereof, Any person violating any provision of this section shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50.00 for each offense.
