

Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE NO. 180.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND SEWERS.

WHEREAS, Since the adoption of the Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1910, an unforeseen emergency has arisen because of the expenses in connection with the Kannah Creek water condemnation suits, the boring for artesian water, and the necessity of making repairs at the pumping plant, the appropriation for the water fund for the said fiscal year has by reason of said emergency been exhausted;

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the purpose of maintaining and defraying the necessary expenses of the Department of Water and Sewers for the remainder of the present fiscal year, ending December 31, 1910, the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its first publication.

Passed and adopted by a unanimous vote of the City Council this 15th day of August, A. D. 1910.
