

Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE NO. 181.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION VIII OF ARTICLE II OF ORDINANCE NO. 92, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING WATERWORKS AND TO REPEAL CERTAIN OTHER ORDINANCES," PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 19TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, A. D. 1900.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 8 of Article II of Ordinance Number 92, entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Waterworks and to Repeal Certain Other Ordinances," passed and adopted the 19th day of February, A. D. 1900, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 8. All persons using water from the City water works shall on the first day of January and July of each year, except as otherwise by this ordinance provided, procure a new license for the use of water, and pay the rent therefor, and if not paid within twenty days, ten per cent penalty shall be added to the rent, and if not paid within thirty days the water shall be shut off. Any person may procure such new license for the use of water and pay rent therefor for the entire year at the time of the January payment, in which event five per cent shall be deducted from one-half of the amount of such annual license fee. Whenever water shall be shut off on account of non-payment of rent it shall not again be turned on until the back rent and the rent for the current semi-annual term be paid, together with one dollar additional to compensate for the trouble and expense of turning off and on the water. Meter rates shall be paid monthly, and ten per cent penalty shall be added to the rent if not paid within twenty days after the same becomes payable, and if not paid within thirty days the water shall be shut off. Where meters are used the back rent shall be paid together with one dollar for the trouble and expense of turning the water off and on, and satisfactory arrangements made with the Commissioner of Water and Sewers that there will be no further delinquency, before the water shall be turned on. In all cases where fire hydrants or other water connections are maintained outside of the limits of the city for purposes of fire protection, the owner of the property so protected shall pay a license fee to the city of fifty (\$50.⁰⁰) dollars per annum for each hydrant or other such water connection, said license fee to be payable at the time and under the conditions of other new license fees.
