

Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE NO. 184.

THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION,
 COLORADO, PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE
 CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY
 1st, A. D. 1911, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31st, A. D. 1911.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction,
 Colorado:

Section 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof
 as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the
 purposes of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the
 City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning Janu-
 ary 1st, A. D. 1911, and ending December 31st, 1911, to-wit:

First.	For Maintaining the Fire Department	\$ 9,500. ⁰⁰
Second.	For Maintaining the Police Department	5,500. ⁰⁰
Third.	For Lighting the Streets and Public Buildings	7,500. ⁰⁰
Fourth.	For Maintaining and Operating the City Water Works	16,000. ⁰⁰
Fifth.	For Maintaining, Improving and Repairing Streets and Alleys, and Water for Irrigation	10,000. ⁰⁰
Sixth.	For the Health Department	5,000. ⁰⁰
Seventh.	For Improvement and Care of Public Parks	3,000. ⁰⁰
Eighth.	For the Public Library	1,500. ⁰⁰
Ninth.	For Salaries of City Officers and Employees	2,500. ⁰⁰
Tenth.	For the General Fund	5,500. ⁰⁰
Eleventh.	For Interest on Water Bonds	7,350. ⁰⁰

Section 2. That for the purpose of defraying the necessary ex-
 penses and liabilities of the said City of Grand Junction for the said
 fiscal year, beginning January 1st, A. D. 1911, and ending December
 31st, A. D. 1911, there shall be and hereby is levied and assessed
 upon all the taxable property situated within the corporate limits of
 said City of Grand Junction, both real and personal, the following
 amounts for special and general taxes, to-wit:

First. For the purpose of defraying the annual interest on
 outstanding water bonds, a special tax of three and three-fourths
 (3 $\frac{3}{4}$) mills on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be
 assessed.

Second. For the purpose of defraying the expenses and mainte-
 nance of the free Public Library, a tax of three-fourths of one ($\frac{3}{4}$ of
 1) mill on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

Third. For the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and
 liabilities of said City of Grand Junction, a tax of twenty-two and
 one-half (22 $\frac{1}{2}$) mills is hereby assessed on each dollar of said prop-
 erty so assessed or to be assessed.

Passed and adopted this 13th day of December, A. D. 1910.
