

Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE N.O. 190.

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO WATER RENTS.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. All persons using water from the City water works shall, on the first day of January, April, July and October, of each year, except as otherwise by this ordinance provided, procure a new license for the use of water, and pay the rent therefor. If paid within ten days from the date the same shall become due and payable, a discount of five per cent. shall be given; if not paid within thirty days, the water shall be shut off. Whenever the water shall be shut off on account of non-payment of water rent, the water shall not be again turned on until the back water rent and the rent for the current quarter shall have been paid, together with one dollar additional for the trouble and expense of shutting off and turning on the water.

Sec. 2. Meter rates shall be paid monthly, and if not paid within thirty days after the same shall become due and payable, the water shall be shut off. Whenever the water shall be shut off on account of non-payment of water rent, the water shall not be again turned on until the back water rent shall have been paid, together with one dollar additional for the trouble and expense of shutting off and turning on the water.

Sec. 3. Beginning July 1, 1911, the following annual rates for the use of water, from the city water works, used within the city limits, are hereby established, payable quarterly in advance, as in this ordinance provided: For each

Residence, hospital, sanitarium, hotel and office building of four rooms or less	\$13.00
and \$2.10 for each additional room over four rooms.	
Drug store	30.00
Bakery and candy factory from \$20.00 to \$30.00 according to the amount of water used.	
Soft drink parlor and club	24.00
Store not otherwise specified	13.00
Soda fountain	6.00
Barber shop, one chair	13.00
each additional chair	3.00
Public bath room, one tub	8.00
each additional tub	4.00
Photograph gallery, \$15.00 to \$25.00, according to the amount of water used.	
Hand laundry	20.00
Steam laundry	170.00
Livery stable, from \$75.00 to \$100.00, according to the amount of water used.	
Public automobile garage, from \$20.00 to \$30.00, according to the amount of water used.	
Dentist's parlor, per chair	6.00
Vegetable fountain	10.00
Urinals	12.00
School house in School District No. 1, 10 cts. per scholar.	
Water sold from hydrants, 50 cts. per tank wagon.	
Metered water, 18 cts. per 1,000 gallons.	
Each bottling establishment, brick yard, chemical laboratory, railway establishment, steam boiler, and all other concerns not mentioned, according to the amount of water used; provided, however, that the minimum annual rent to any water user shall be \$13.00.	

Restaurants, from \$15.00 to \$30.00, according to the amount of water used.

Sec. 4. All persons using water outside of the city limits shall pay double the rate fixed in Section 3 hereof.

Sec. 5. Ordinance No. 186 is hereby repealed.
