Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE NO. 209.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 206, PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 3RD DAY OF DECEMBER, 1912, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO WATER RENTS."

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Celerado:

That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 206, passed and adopted the 3rd day of December, 1912, and entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 4. The following monthly rentals for water used within the city limits and measured by meter shall be paid:

- For quantities less than 100,000 gallens, 15 cents per 1,000 gallens, with a maximum charge of \$12.00 for the entire quantity used.
- For quantities of 100,000 gallens and less than 400,000 gallens, 12 cents per thousand gallens, with a maximum charge of \$40.00 for the entire quantity used.
- For quantities of 400,000 gallens and less than one million gallens, 10 cents per thousand gallens, with a maximum charge of \$90.00 for the entire quantity used.
- For quantities of one million gallons and less than two million gallons, 9 cents per thousand gallons, with a maximum charge of \$160.00 for the entire quantity used. d.
- For quantities of two million gallons and less than three million gallons, 8 cents per thousand gallons, with a maximum charge of \$210.00 for the entire quantity used.
- For quantities of three million gallons and less than four million gallons, 7 cents per thousand gallons, with a maximum charge of \$240.00 for the entire quantity used.
- For quantities of four million gallons and less than five million gallons, 6 cents per thousand gallons, with a maximum charge of \$ 250.00 for the entire quantity E. .
- For quantities of five million gallons and over, five cents per thousand gallens.
