

Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE NO. 211.

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO LICENSES.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. No person shall engage in the occupation or profession or business or practice of and as a Clairvoyant, Mesmerist, Card Reader, Fortune Teller, Palmist, Seer, Trance Medium, Test Medium, Phrenologist, or Psychometrist, without first having submitted to the Mayor of this city evidence of good character, reliability and the filing of a bond and procuring a license therefor as hereinafter provided.

Sec. 2. For the purpose of carrying out the terms of this ordinance, the terms above enumerated shall be deemed and held to include the aforementioned characters or persons who shall in any manner advertise and hold themselves out to the public as being proficient in or as engaged in the respective occupations, callings or professions for public or private patronage, who shall charge any price or admission or fee for any act done or information or advice given or service rendered of any kind or character pertaining to or done by, through or in accordance with the said occupation, calling or profession they represent.

Sec. 3. A license to carry on the said occupation, calling or profession may be issued after written application by the party desiring the license to the Mayor of the city, and the presentation to the said Mayor of the evidence and certificates of good character and the filing of a bond in the sum of \$500.00 to insure the proper conduct of their said business, and the approval of the Mayor thereon and for the payment of a license fee, which shall be \$200.00 per annum, or \$50.00 for a period of one month, or \$5.00 for a period of one day. Provided, that such license shall not be transferable from one person to another.

Sec. 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00 for each offence.
