

# Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

## ORDINANCE NO. 213.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY WATER WORKS.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1913, an unforeseen contingency has arisen because the expenses of operation and maintenance of the Kannah Creek water system have exceeded the amount deemed sufficient for such operation and maintenance, and the appropriation for the water fund for the said fiscal year has, by reason of said contingency, been exhausted:

Wherefore, Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of maintaining and defraying the necessary expenses of the City Water Works for the remainder of the present fiscal year, ending December 31, 1913, the sum of \$1,500.00.
