Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado

ORDINANCE.NO. 214.

ANORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ADDITION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO ELECTION
PRECINCT NUMBER TWELVE.

WHEREAS, there has recently been taken into the limits of the City of Grand Junction certain territory which is hereinafter described, and said territory has not been placed in any precinct within the City of Grand Junction, for the purpose of registration and voting in municipal elections; and

WHEREAS, a regular city election is to be held in the said city of Grand Junction on November 4, 1913; and

WHEREAS, a case of special emergency exists in order to provide for the registration and voting of the qualified electors residing in said territory; therefore,

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That all of the northeast quarter of Section Twenty-three, Township One South, Range One West, Ute Meridian, except the following described tracts:

- (a.) The West twe hundred thirty-twe feet of the North half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section Twenty-three;
 - (b) The Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section Twenty-three;
 - (c) The South Three-quarters of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section Twenty-three; shall be and hereby is for the purpose of registration and voting in the city elections, made a part of Precinct Number Twelve of the County of Mesa and State of Colorado.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and shall be in force from and after its first publication.

Passed and adopted by a unanimous vete of the City Council this let day of October, A. D. 1913.
